



•The rate of possessing a PC at home was above 70%. Nearly 80% of them surf the net at home. The proportion of internet use is highest among 30- to 39-year-old males and 25- to 29-year-old females.

< Method of calculating the average number of days connected to internet > $^{\Gamma}$ almost everydayı :7days, $^{\Gamma}$ 4-5 days a weekı :4.5days, $^{\Gamma}$ 2-3days a weekı :0.3days, $^{\Gamma}$ 1 days a monthı :0.1days.

Approximately half of the internet users surfed the net "almost everyday" at home. The average number of days connected to internet in a week was 4.7 days. 25- to 29-year-old females, who scored the highest rate of net surfing at home, had the average of 6.3 days in a week connected to internet.
